# Mandalay Region Hluttaw's Second Regular Session (First Day) Commenced



Monday, June 13, 2016

The Second Regional Hluttaw for Mandalay commenced the first day of Second Regular Session today with 13 programs attending 54 MPs including the Speaker of Hluttaw and 19 military representatives at 10 am at the meeting hall of Mandalay Region Hluttaw.

During the session, the representatives of respective departments from Mandalay Region answered the 12 questions of MPs from regional parliament. The proposed bill that amended the city development law submitted and one of the MPs has conceded that amended bill. Then the consideration of parliament for the bill had been sounded out and parliament proclaimed that MPs could submit the name list to parliament if they would like to discuss on it.

Then, also during the session, the Speaker put up modified and replaced lists of 6 committees members: chair-person, secretary-general and the members. After that, one MP read the report related with the bill amended 2014 Mandalay City Development Law to the parliament. The first day of the Second Parliament Session stopped at 11:10 am and the second session (second day) would be held at 10:00 am on 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2016.

#### Yangon Region Hluttaw Approved Proposal to Hand Over the Right of Ownership for Public Areas to People

Yangon Region Hluttaw approved proposal to hand over the right of ownership for public areas to people after the arguments during hluttaw session held on 16<sup>th</sup> June, 2016.

The proposal submitted by U Nay Phone Latt, MP from Thingangkuun Constituency 1, was to prevent the problematic issues such as the acts of trespass; rent and sale with grant the public areas done by governmental departments and to reveal these actions as much as Hluttaw could.

For this proposal, the Mayor replied just to record as one of the Hluttaw documentations but MP who submitted the proposal did not accept and asked for Hluttaw's consideration. Then almost all of the MPs have supported the proposal so that Parliament approved it.

U Tin Maung Tun, the Speaker of Hluttaw, asked attending MPs to stand up if they supported the proposal and almost all of the MPs including military representatives had shown their support by standing up.

Then the Speaker asked again Hluttaw attendees to stand up if there were any objection and U Maung Maung Soe, the Mayor and the Minister of the Ministry of Yangon Region Development, has solely stood up.

"It was not an objection for proposal. The reason I stood up was to reveal the case study to settle issues. The proposal is totally right. I was just to put up my case study to Hluttaw", said the Mayor.

Then, Yangon City Development Committee has been contesting a legal suit related to the removal of the four-storey market by the side of Thingangkuun Market Yangon Eastern District Court and Committee will obey and carry out in accordance with the final decision of the Court, continued the Mayor.

For this proposal, 14 MPs from NLD has supported and discussed during the Session. The debate time for the proposal had lasted for 2 hours.

As the proposal was approved by Hluttaw, regional government has to implement and settle the issues composed in the proposal.


